# Wordpress installation

## Steps to add your calculator to your Wordpress pages

- Install the plugin:download, and unzip the contents under your WP/wp-content/plugins/ folder
- Activate the plugin through the 'Plugins' menu in WordPress, and enter your XLSJuice account settings at the configuration page
- Create your calculator form at xlsjuice.com and copy the id of the calculator you get at the last step
- Insert at any page using this shortcode, for ex: for a calculator with code YYYYYZZZZZZ , insert at your page:

```
[xlsjuice code="YYYYYZZZZZZ"]
```

You will see your calculator up and running inside your Wordpress

# Add user data from your Wordpress

You can import actual logged-in user data from your Wordpress to your form configuring 'Value' field on your input [Text](#) or [Hidden](#).

Type '#External:' followed by the data from user you want to get. Here is a list of data available with the value to use:

- Id: **#External:id**
- Name: **#External:name**
- User Name: **#External:username**
- Email: **#External:email**

Note that you'd need to install this [Wordpress plugin](#) and publish the calculator at your WP page following the instructions from the download page.

Validation	<input type="text"/>
Value	<input type="text" value="#External:email"/>
Placeholder	<input type="text"/>
Size	<input type="text"/>

With this example settings you'll get at your form one text input filled by default with the actual wordpress user email.
